DERBY CLINIC

Riders are expected to ride in clean safe tack and apparel. Riders are expected to be courteous to the clinician and other riders and arrive early or on time. Riders will be assigned volunteer slots to assist with setting rails for other groups. Please expect to arrive early if you are the first group and stay late if you are the last group.

Groups are a maximum of four when possible and will be 1.5 hour time slots. Please have your horse warmed up for you ride time to maximize time with the clinician

Description of SPHC Derby Layout:

Each horse and rider will complete a dressage test prior to the jumping phase.

Jumping phase will consist of modified stadium course starting in the show ring prior to heading straight onto cross country course

- The SPHC will follow Equine Canada Cross Country rules for dress & tack, no exceptions.
- Ride times will be posted via Startbox during the week of the clinic.
- Riders may pick up packages starting at 2pm on Thursday at the show office located by the upper rings. Course will not be open for walking until 2hrs after final clinic lesson has been completed.
- Course descriptions, length and number of obstacles will be given in rider packages.

Derby Information

Show office opens at 7:00am both days. The show secretary will be on site for the duration of the Derby.

- A \$50 admin fee will be applied to any entries cancelled with vet or Dr note.
- No unauthorized motor vehicles allowed on course.
- **Clinic is first received first entered; AT THIS TIME WE ARE NOT accepting derby entries for non clinic riders. **we will assess the week before****
- No unleashed dogs. All owners must clean up after their dogs. No exceptions.
- Vet will be on-call
- Derby officials have the right to remove any horse or rider combination due to unsafe riding at any time.
- Coaching on course at this Derby is not permitted and may result in rider disqualification.
- All riders must wear an approved helmet, protective vest and piny for jumping phases, Horse and rider must have a number on.
- Dressage phase must be in appropriate show attire.

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SCORING

There will be an audible signal to start. Circles on course will be scored as refusals, EXCEPT when called as not presenting.

- Knock Down- 4 points – 1st refusal 4 points – 2nd refusal at the same fence 8 points 3rd refusal at the same fence **elimination**.
- Exceeding Optimum Time (per second) 1 point
- Fall of competitor or horse- **elimination**
- 4 refusals on course- **elimination**
- Exceeding time limit- **elimination**
- Leaving course – **elimination**
- Combinations lettered “AB” will be jumped per EC rules. I.e. if B is refused, A must be re-jumped upon second presentation.

Closest to Optimum time (under time) and lowest score wins.

DERBY PRIZES & AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to 6th in all divisions. Prizes will be awarded to the top three riders in each height division.

Championship prizes will be awarded to the best overall Junior & Senior Score in Each Derby Day.

An Overall Derby Champion will be calculated by the combined scores of all two derby days through any division for one rider.

In the event of a suspected scoring error: Please bring any scoring errors to the attention of the show secretary within 30 mins of posted scores.
