

## SPHC 2021 Covid-19 Clinic Policy

To ensure the health and safety of all participants and clinicians South Peace Horse Club asks that while on the grounds you adhere to the rules set forth by Alberta Health services for outdoor activities. <https://www.alberta.ca/guidance-on-outdoor-activities.aspx>

### Participants

- Must maintain a physical distance of at least 2m or 6ft from others unless they are from the same household during, before and after activities.
- Refrain from sharing equipment
- Park in designated areas to maintain physical distance while at your vehicle
- Riders from one group at a time are permitted in ring with clinician and one jump person
- If personal contact is necessary then gloves, mask and other PPE should be worn.
- Disinfect high traffic areas before and after use.
- Practice good hand hygiene avoid touching your face
- Do not share drinks or food
- Do Not participate if you are sick or have been in contact with someone who is sick
- Do Not enter the grounds if you or someone you have been in contact with is displaying any known symptoms of Covid-19 (Cough, Fever. Chest pain, difficulty breathing)

Evergreen Park will be doing spot checks to ensure Alberta Health guidelines are being followed and may stop the clinic and future events if we are not in compliance. Please play safe and maintain social distancing at all times.

I declare that I will not for any reason arrive at the facility if:

- I am experiencing any known symptoms of Covid-19(Cough, Fever, chest pain, difficulty breathing)
- I share a household or have come in contact with someone with or displaying symptoms of Covid-19
