THE SOCIETIES ACT
(Section 7)

APPLICATION

We, the undersigned, hereby declare that we desire to form a society under The Societies Act, and that

1. The name of the society is "South Peace Show-Horse Association"
2. The objects of the society are:
 - (a) To encourage the breeding and showing of horses and particularly to sponsor an annual exhibition and horse show in the South Peace;
 - (b) To encourage matches and competitions of various breeds of horses;
 - (c) To promote interest in agriculture, horticulture and stock raising;
 - (d) To bring to the attention of the public the good qualities and merits of the various breeds of horses;
 - (e) To endeavour to establish a reputation for various breeds of horses in the South Peace;
 - (f) To encourage the registration or entry of stallions and mares in the Registry;
 - (g) To further the interests of the community generally;
 - (h) To foster interest in equitation;
 - (i) To bring together the equestrians for mutual enjoyment of and to further the knowledge of horsemanship/
 - (j) To organize, promote and manage appropriate affairs such as gymkhanas, horse shows, rides, horse races, lectures, demonstrations and other affairs which may be decided upon;
 - (k) To promote better relationship with native people;
